

Fulfilled Sermon Series: Life Group Discussion Questions

February 24 – “They Testify About Me” Sermon Questions

1. What has been your personal experience of finding Jesus in the Old Testament? Is this a newer way of looking at the Old Testament for you, or something you are generally used to and comfortable with? Are there any concerns or cautions you have with reading scripture this way?
2. The sermon mentioned four primary ways that we find Jesus in the Old Testament: 1) prophecy, 2) typology, 3) Christophanies, 4) redemptive-historical progressions. Which of these are you most excited to explore more, or which do you have the most questions about?
3. Jesus saw Jonah as a type of himself, even though the author of Jonah did not intend the story of Jonah to be a prophecy about the messiah. Likewise, Paul explains that Adam was a type of Christ, in that his one action affected many. How far are we allowed to go today in finding types of Christ in the Old Testament? What is appropriate, and what is crossing the line in finding Christ in the OT?
4. Read Genesis 22 all the way through as a group. After you finish, talk about any ways you see that it may point to Christ.
5. The sermon mentioned how identifying Christ in the Old Testament benefits our faith through seeing God’s sovereignty, Christ’s supremacy, and scripture’s unity. Do any of these resonate with you, or do you see any other benefits to our faith and ministry as believers?
