Get to Know You Questions

1. If you didn't have to sleep, what would you do with the extra time?
2. What was your church background? What is one positive and one negative way that it impacted you or your faith journey?

Into the Bible Questions

3. What stood out to you from the sermon? If there was one point to carry away, what would it be?
4. Jesus is called “the Son of David” in the New Testament (Mt. 1:1; 21:9; Mk 10:48). Divide your lifegroup into two groups, and look up the assigned passages. Answer these questions:
 - Group 1 Passages: Isaiah 9:7, 16:4b-5, Jeremiah 23:5-8; 30:8-11; 33:14-16
 - 1. What do we learn about who Jesus is through these prophecies?
 - 2. What has not yet been fully fulfilled from these prophecies?
 - Group 2 Passages: Ezekiel 34:22-24; 37:24-28; Hosea 3:4-5; Amos 9:11-15
 - 1. What do we learn about who Jesus is through these prophecies?
 - 2. What has not yet been fully fulfilled from these prophecies?
5. The sermon mentioned one possible reason for why God allowed the people to have a human king, even though their request was called “a great wickedness” later. What are some other possible reasons why God would have allowed the people to have their earthly king if it was not his original good intention for them?

Application Questions

6. Israel tried to find security in an earthly king rather than solely in God. What are you tempted to go to rather than the Lord to be satisfied or to find security?
7. Spend some time in prayer as a group that each member would truly find their satisfaction and security in him. Suggested to break into small groups for this so that each member can receive specific prayer for their situation as needed.
