## March 3 - "The Promised One" Sermon Questions

### Get to Know You Question (Optional)

1. Have one or two people share:
  - What is one significant moment you have had with God that has shaped you?
  - What do you feel is one of your roles within the body of Christ?

OR

2. Have each member of your group share what aspect of being part of a church is the most valuable to them? (e.g. Biblical teaching, worship/worship style, community and fellowship, particular types of service opportunities, etc.)

### Digging Deeper Questions

3. Read Galatians 4:4-5 as a group. Why do you think God waited until he did to send Jesus?
4. Revelation 13:8 (KJV, NIV) says that the Lamb of God was slain before the foundation of the world. What do you think this means? What are the implications of what is being taught here?
5. If there is time, break up the group into smaller groups of two or three and assign each to one of the following passages: 1) Gen 3 2) Gen 4:1-16 3) Gen 8:20-9:17  
Each group will look into their text and answer the following questions:
  - What aspects of this story find greater fulfillment in Christ? How might this story point to Christ?
  - What are any New Testament passages/cross-references that exemplify how this passage relates to Christ and the New Covenant?
  - Present what you find to the rest of the life group.
