March 10 – “The Lamb of God” Sermon Questions

Get to Know You Question (Optional)

1. If your house was burning down and your family was already safe, what would you grab if you had time to grab just one last thing and why?
2. What do you feel is one of your roles within the body of Christ? What have you discovered so far as your spiritual gift(s)?

Into the Bible Questions

3. What is the connection between “the shedding of blood” and “forgiveness?” Reference Hebrews 9:22 and Exodus 12:1-13 for biblical insight.
4. The Book of Revelation names Jesus as “the Lamb” at least 30 times. Why do you think the Apostle John most commonly refers to Jesus as the Lamb? Two examples include:
 - Revelation 5:5-6: Then one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals.” Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing at the center of the throne, encircled by the four living creatures and the elders.
 - Revelation 12:11: They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony; they did not love their lives so much as to shrink from death.
5. Read Hebrews 9:1-14 as a group. Unpack the significance of this text for our lives in Christ. What stands out to you from this passage?

Application Questions

6. Think back on your own journey with Christ. Have you clearly sensed the cleansing of your conscience that Hebrews talks about, or has it been difficult for you to feel freed from condemnation? What has helped you or hindered you from sensing that cleaning?
7. Spend some time in prayer as a group for those who desire a deeper sense of the completeness of Christ’s sacrifice in their souls, and for any other prayer requests if there is time.
