### Get to Know You Questions

1. What was the best vacation you ever took and why?
2. The concept of community and being part of the body of Christ is paramount in the New Testament. What do you think are the primary distinguishers of a Christian community versus any other tight-knit community you might find?

### Into the Bible Questions

3. How do you understand “going beyond the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees” (Matthew 5:20)?
4. In the sermon there was a distinction made between “student” and “apprentice.” How has this distinction stimulated your thinking in terms of discipleship?
5. Read Ezekiel 36:25-27 and Psalm 51:10. What are the implications of these passages in relation to being “born again” (especially found in the Ezekiel passage)? What 3 things actually happen?

### Application Questions

6. The call to discipleship was linked to Jesus’ question in John 1:35-39, “What are you seeking?” What might you find yourself “seeking first” in your life? Do you sense the Lord prompting you to make any adjustments to your priorities?
