Get to Know You Questions

1. If you could share a meal with any two individuals living or dead who would they be?
2. If you could ask Jesus one question what would it be?

Into the Bible Questions

3. What point or concept stood out to you most from this week’s sermon?
4. Discuss the ways that we are supposed to pattern are lives after Jesus vs the ways in which he is unique and we are not supposed to emulate him?
5. If Jesus lived in our culture and time, what issues or parts of our culture do you believe Jesus would have engaged as a priority and why? Do you believe the church does well in prioritizing the same things Jesus would?

Application Questions

6. What aspect of Jesus’ teaching, actions, or character has had the most profound impact on your life?
7. Jesus talks about not having a place to lay his head and his followers being willing and ready to follow him wherever and whenever he calls. Applying this can be difficult, especially in relation to holding a strong sense of responsibility and desire to provide and care for our families. How do we balance the tension between Jesus’ words and responsibly caring for a family?
