Get to Know Each Other

1. If you could turn any activity into an Olympic sport, what would you have a good chance at winning a medal for?
2. What was your church background? What is one positive and one negative way that it impacted you or your faith journey?

Going Deeper

3. Think of one community from your past that had a profound impact on you. What aspect of that group makes it stand out from other communities that you have not felt as connected to?
4. The concept of community and being part of the body of Christ is paramount in the New Testament. What do you think are the primary distinguishers of a Christian community versus any other tight-knit community you might find?
5. In the sermon, the preacher mentioned four aspects of gospel-centered community: 1) grows as disciples together, 2) does life together, 3) sacrifices for one another, and 4) joyfully praises God together. Discuss what it would look like for your own group to practically walk each of these out.

Application

6. What is one way that you feel God might be calling you to personally invest in this lifegroup over the next 10 weeks? What is something you have to bring to the group, whether a passion, a gifting, or a way to serve and engage?
7. End in prayer for each other. It is up to the lifegroup leader how they would like to facilitate this.
