Get to Know Each Other

1. If you could turn any activity into an Olympic sport, what would you have a good chance at winning a medal for?
2. What was your church background? What is one positive and one negative way that it impacted you or your faith journey?

Going Deeper

3. Knowing that the Bible’s primary intention is to reveal the character and nature of God rather than to simply make people morally good, how does this shape the way you approach interpreting and understanding Scripture? What are the most helpful questions we can ask when looking at any passage?
4. Read Genesis 1. What are some of the things we learn about the nature and character of God from this chapter?
5. The sermon talked about how the Bible is held together as one cohesive story by the covenants God has made with his people, while culture thinks that religion is about doing more good than bad. What difference does it make in our lives to recognize that we are in covenant with God (as his people have always been), and not just trying to be “a good person”?
